




Had access to a supportive and inclusive community of peers and professionals where they could bring their whole selves




*5-point Likert Scale (% of respondents with strongly agree and agree ratings)



Had access to career learning opportunities tailored to their needs as a Black, Indigenous or woman of colour.




Had access to learning opportunities that covered strategies for navigating the workplace as a Black, Indigenous or woman of colour.






